### 2 Letchworth Rugby Club

A rent assistance grant of £5,940 was approved.

### 3 Whitethorn Wanderers Football Club

A 'Sporting Success' grant of £1,000 was approved towards equipment costs for this new under 16 side.

#### **4 Herts & Beds Ambulance Service**

The Board approved a grant of £3,250 under the Foundation's 'relief of poverty and sickness' Object towards the cost of two sets of equipment for Letchworth First Responders.

#### **5 Norton Community Archaeology Group**

A grant of £10,575 over three years was approved under the Foundation's 'preservation of buildings and environment' Object towards the cost of translating manorial court records subject to the Group securing the remaining required funding.

#### **6 Heritage Grants**

A grant towards the cost of forthcoming work at this property was approved [Charitable Object 2.i 'preservation of buildings and environment']:

- 39 Broadwater Avenue – replacement of front door in timber.

#### **7 Landlords Consent**

The following applications were approved:

- 42 Aubreys – part demolition of a free standing garage and replacement of a ground floor side extension.
- 62 Broadwater Avenue – replacement open glazed rear windows subject to the issue of a moratorium notice.

#### **8 Letchworth Town Centre Revitalisation**

The Arcade: refurbishment works had been completed.  
Streetscene: the decision of Hertfordshire County Council to withdraw their approval to works for the Birds Hill roundabout to go ahead in the Christmas period would result of completion of the Scheme being delayed until 7 May 2010.

#### **9 Appointment of Vice Chairman**

The Board elected Bob Williams to serve as Vice Chairman of the Foundation with immediate effect.
